Congratulations on your decision to apply to Lehigh Carbon Community College! This is the first step in fulfilling your educational and career goals. Here is important information to review before you complete the application.

Who should apply for admission to the College?

Anyone who has not applied previously for credit courses should complete an application.

Note: If you have taken credit courses in the past, you do not need to complete an application.

How to apply for admission to the College:

1. Complete and submit the application for admission. Students should apply as early as possible to ensure adequate time for educational planning, financial aid processing, veterans' certification, and placement testing.
2. Request that your high school send an official transcript if you are:
 - a high school senior or graduate,
 - applying for admission to a restricted program*
 - applying for financial aid.

GED recipients should submit a copy of their equivalency diploma and the percentile score report.

3. If you have attended another college, request that official transcripts be sent to the Office of Enrollment Services.
4. Submit a nonrefundable application fee. This \$30 fee is required for all applicants who are not currently enrolled in a sponsoring school district. A check or money order made payable to Lehigh Carbon Community College must accompany this application. Applications will not be processed until the fee is paid. Please do not send cash.

An acceptance letter will be sent from the college with instructions on how to proceed with enrollment. The Financial Aid office encourages all students to apply for financial aid by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

*What is a restricted admission program?

Restricted admission programs are programs that have additional admission requirements. When an application for a restricted program is received, the applicant will be considered a Liberal Arts major until accepted by the restricted program.
