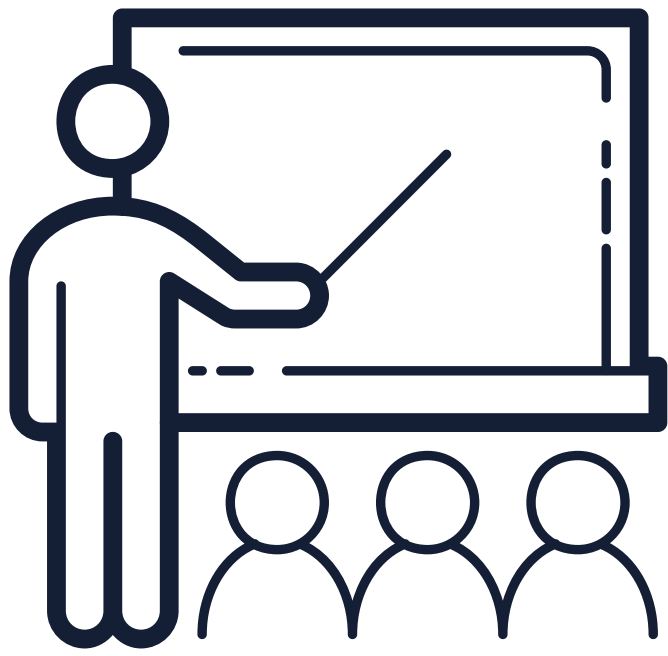




Guide to Fall



Face-to-Face Class

Definition: Traditional face-to-face instruction in a classroom on campus.

Fall 2020: Only offered if we are in the **Green** for specific classes, such as labs and clinicals. These classes are noted as such in the Course Search.

Remote Class

Definition: Live, real-time instruction done virtually/remotely. Uses software like Zoom so that students and instructors can interact live. Classes will be held on specific days and times.

Fall 2020: In Course Search these classes will be listed "Remote" as the Location and Site will be "Distance Education."



Online Class

Definition: Course content, assignments, and all assessments are within Canvas. Canvas is software which is accessed through your MyLCCC portal. Online classes have specific due dates but students are required to independently read the content and complete the objectives of the class within Canvas at prescribed deadlines.

Fall 2020: In Course Search these classes are identified by the letter N or XN. Example ENG 105-N2. "Online" will be listed as the Location and Site will be "Distance Education."

Hybrid Class

Definition: Blend of instruction (either face-to-face or virtually/remote) with an online course in Canvas. At least 50% of instruction occurs in a live format (face-to-face or virtual/remote).

Fall 2020: In Course Search these classes are identified by the letters HY. For example PSY140-HY1. Students must have access to a computer, Internet service, and possess basic computer, Internet and email skills.
