

EMT TRAINING Scholarships



For veterans and active service members residing in Lehigh County



Scholarships are available of up to \$1,488 each in the Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) noncredit program. Funding covers full tuition and books.

Completers will be certified by the Pennsylvania Department of Health and eligible to sit for the National Registry EMT credential.

Requirements:

- Minimum of 18 years old and resident of Lehigh County
- Military persons must show proof of military service
- Physician release form and proof of health insurance
- Must have a goal to secure a job as an EMT or continue in post-secondary education after completing the program
- Applicants must meet with a Job Training-Healthcare Specialist and complete a noncredit course registration form and any additional enrollment requirements
