



## Technical Standards

In order to maximize the effectiveness of the **Success, Engagement, Education, Determination** [SEED] program for participants, the following criteria have been established to assist potential participants in determining whether or not this is the right program for them.

**The following standards are considered requirements for eligibility to the program:**

- Must have a documented disability
- Must be at least 18 years old
- Must be able to independently and safely navigate the college environment, as there may not always be supervision
- Must have basic safety skills in an unsupervised setting
- Must have completed high school academic requirements
- Must have the ability to learn, work, and participate in a classroom, group, and/or work settings
- Must be able to meet LCCC student code of conduct [found at <https://www.lccc.edu/student-experience/lccc-code-of-student-conduct>]
- Must have functional reading and writing skills
- Must arrange transportation to and from campus, SEED related activities, and/or work environments.
- Must meet eligibility guidelines for state agencies (i.e. Vocational Rehabilitation, Adult Developmental Disability Agencies, Medicaid)
- Must be goal oriented and internally motivated
