I am an aspiring nursing student and I strongly feel by expanding my chemistry course through the Honors experience will be a tremendous asset to future studies.

Gas care is essential in Healthcare science in many applications because, the delivery of oxygen to cells is crucial for life. In fact compressed gasses are used every day for a multitude of uses in a hospital. These uses include ventilators, oxygen masks and even in detection equipment to monitor the concentration of gasses dissolved in blood.
