LCCC Recognized for Efforts to Support Mental Health and Prevent Suicide

On May 27, the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) recognized 15 postsecondary institutions across the Commonwealth for their commitment to preventing suicide and promoting mental health and wellness for their learners. The event was held at Temple University and Brian DeLong, Associate Dean of Student Development, attended the event to receive the certificate on behalf of LCCC. PA CARES is a newly created recognition that ensures postsecondary students have access to support, tools and resources to learn and thrive. "It is everyone's responsibility to collaborate, cooperate and connect to ensure Pennsylvania's postsecondary students have access to safe and supportive learning environments, and the PA CARES initiative recognizes the school communities that are doing the work day in and day out," said Deputy Secretary of Postsecondary and Higher Education, Dr. Lynette Kuhn. "We applaud these 15 colleges and universities for recognizing the importance of coming together for the learners on their campuses, and proactively working to enhance mental health and prevent suicide."

Quick Reference for Medical Emergencies on Campus

If serious injury or illness occurs on campus, CALL 911. After you call 911, call Public Safety at x1169 to inform them you called 911. Public Safety will report to where the injured person is until arrival of the ambulance.

For minor injury or illness, trained personnel should provide basic first aid care. Call Public Safety at x1169. All Public Safety officers are trained in first aid and CPR/AEDS.

No employee shall transport another employee/student to an emergency facility or hospital.

LCCC Offers New Program in Cybersecurity Starting in Fall 2025

People interested in a career in the fast growing cybersecurity industry are encouraged to explore the new LCCC degree program in Cybersecurity beginning in the fall 2025 semester. Be prepared to work in this emerging career and learn to secure digital systems, networks and infrastructures from evolving cyber threats.

In the program, students can start with the three-course diploma, build on that with the one-year certificate and then complete the associate degree, which can be used to transfer into a bachelor's degree. This stackable approach prepares students to take a series of certifications along the way, becoming more and more qualified for additional positions and responsibilities in the industry.

Students will gain technical skills and strategic insights to protect sensitive information, secure operating systems and safeguard network architectures. Courses lay a solid foundation of cybersecurity knowledge and skills and then add specific defensive and offensive knowledge and skills. Graduates will be prepared for a series of industry-recognized certifications.

Pay for positions in the cybersecurity industry start in the range of \$21 an hour for entry level and rise to \$60 an hour for employees with an associate degree. Career paths include Cybersecurity Analyst, IT Technician, Security Engineer, and Security Administrator, to name a few. Professionals in the industry are in high demand.

Cybersecurity courses in the fall are being offered online and include Computer Ethics, Network Security and Cybersecurity Analyst. More information is available on the <u>college's webpage</u>.
