The college recently experienced a cybersecurity incident brought to our attention by a federal government

agency. A Russian state-sponsored hacking group is suspected to have breached the LCCC virtual computer lab system. While the purpose of this breach is not yet known, we have no indication that confidential or sensitive data was accessible to the attacker nor were they able to gain access to any other college systems. Upon discovering the breach, college IT staff acted to immediately contain and remove access as well as prevent future infiltration. The college is working with the government agency and has retained private cybersecurity specialists to complete a full forensic investigation. This is the latest reminder that LCCC is a target of cyber criminals. It is imperative that everyone remains

security minded, avoid suspicious emails, use multi-factor authentication (MFA), and protect sensitive data. We encourage you to review our security and support related documentation in the LCCC IT Knowledge Base.


