

DUAL ENROLLMENT VOUCHER

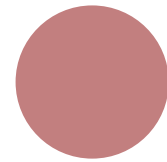

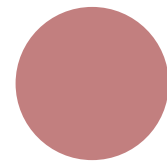
