Studio Navigation Update & Picture-in-Picture Support

There is a new navigation experience that has been adapted by the Canvas Studio user interface. In the previous design there was a tray on the left that you opened to get your other options. Now those options have been moved to the top of the screen so you can easily see them as you navigate. As you click on each option a collapsible menu will appear for each instead of taking you to the page like before.

Studio Capture now has Picture-In-Picture support. Similar to using the Share screen and Webcam mode in the Screen-Cast-O-Matic. After you choose Studio Capture from the create options in Studio you will share what screen you wish, and then choose the Picture-In-Picture to also share your webcam at the same time. You can move the webcam box around the area of your screen as well. As of right now, webcam sharing is only available when sharing the entire screen.
