As both a veteran and returning adult student, I came to LCCC with no idea of what benefits or help I was eligible for and had no idea how the process would work – I had been out of school for 15 years.

The Veteran Services team helped me navigate the process and ease my transition to college. They guided me through the process of accessing my benefits, scheduling my courses, and introduced me to fellow veterans. They welcomed me into the Veterans Club, which helped me feel even more at home. I am now on the path to earning my degree and starting my next career.
